Catering contract

As part of our ongoing commitment of ensuring quality and cost-effective catering, we have secured a new catering service contract with Mellors. Please be advised that from September 2020, school meal prices will be

- Primary pupils: **£3.15**
- Secondary and 6th form pupils: **£3.35**

Please be assured that I recognise the short notice of this information, which has taken a lot of work during the summer term and the summer holidays, in order for us to finalise this contract ready for the new school year.

Some parents/carers will have been contacted via phone today in regards to allergen information, I have enclosed a copy of this information for you to look through in case you have any questions regarding the menu.

As we return to school I must stress the importance of keeping your child / young person off school if they, or any member of their family are showing symptoms of Coronavirus. These include:

- a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Please continue to access the latest guidance, particularly the updates from the Government website for clarification. If you have any of the main symptoms of coronavirus:

1. Get a test to check if you have Coronavirus as soon as possible.
2. Stay at home and do not have visitors until you get your test result – only leave your home to have a test.

If anybody in school presents with any of these symptoms, you will be notified by letter. This will enable us all to remain vigilant.
